"Occult Residual Ovarian Tissue at the Time of Risk Reducing Surgery: Practice Implications"

Objectives:

- 1. To describe extension of microscopic ovarian tissue beyond visible and proposed riskreducing margins
- 2. To update surgical recommendations for adequate minimally invasive risk-reducing salpingo-oophorectomy in patients with pathogenic BRCA mutations, specifically as regards ligation of the infundibulopelvic ligament
- 3. To provide contemporary estimates of incident precancerous, atypical and hyperplastic lesions detected at the time of risk-reducing surgery
